

Spring Cleaning Checklist

Throughout the house

- Check all smoke alarms.
- Dust lighting fixtures.
- Wash doors, walls and baseboards
- Vacuum all lamp shades
- Wash Windows & window sills
- Vacuum vent covers.
- Vacuum (or launder) curtains.
- Clean blinds.
- Wash & sanitize all trash cans inside and out.



Kitchen

- Organize drawers & cupboards by removing each item, vacuuming out debris and wiping.
- Before returning items to the drawers, sort through and set aside items for donation.
- Sharpen knives, sanitize cutting boards
- Wash cabinet doors inside and out.
- Remove everything from the fridge & freezer, throw out expired items, and wipe down inside.
- Organize pantry and throw out any expired items.
- Clean stove top and oven.
- Vacuum out drawer under stove.
- Vacuum under appliances.
- Wipe edges of dishwasher door.



Closets

(Bedrooms and Entry Closets)

- Place winter boots/clothing in storage
- Donate any out grown or not needed items
- Vacuum/wash floor of closet
- Wash front door mat or shake out and vacuum



Living Areas

- Dust art
- Vacuum sofas including under cushions.
- Wash throw pillows and blankets according to directions.
- Dust shelves, furniture and decor.
- Carefully dust electronics using canned air.
- Sort through and donate unused books, magazines, DVDs etc.
- Move larger furniture and vacuum under (such as sofas)



Bedrooms

- Sort through closet (as above)
- Vacuum under the bed (and remove any items hiding under there)
- Flip mattress (if applicable).
- Sprinkle with baking soda and vacuum.
- Wash pillows.



Bathrooms

- Sort through and discard expired medications and toiletries.
- Check all first aid kits for supplies and expiry dates.
- Wash bath mats and shower curtains.
- Reseal any grout and replace any caulking that is cracked.
- Vacuum & wipe drawers & vanity.
- Remove toilet seat and clean around seat bolts.
